Application of Erazo LDR Liquid

Erazo LDR Liquid is designed to be used undiluted

All Surfaces

Dampen a clean cloth with Erazo LDR Liquid . Dab and wipe off the graffiti, turning the cloth frequently to ensure the mark is not returned to the surface. Wipe off any residue with a clean damp cloth then rinse the surface. For best results, rinse with Guardisan® Fresh.

If preferred you can apply the liquid with a brush then continue agitating to remove the graffiti. Ensure that the surface is kept wet, if necessary reapply the liquid. Wipe and rinse as above.

Cautionary Notes

Always test a small area first to check for surface compatibility.

Do not use paper to agitate unless it is very soft.
